Defining these phrases with their correct meanings:

1. To ask for someone's hand in marriage– Ask someone to marry you
2. To be made for each other – Two people who get along extremely well
3. Love at first sight –To fall in love with someone the first time that one sees him or her
4. Puppy love- Infatuation between school-age children or teenagers.

How they might be used in a sentence:
