



Time Idioms

There are a number of phrases and idioms that are used when describing time.

1. In no time
2. At the crack of dawn
3. At the eleventh hour
4. Burn the midnight oil

Defining these phrases with their correct meanings:

1. In no time – very shortly, soon
2. At the crack of dawn – at daybreak, when the sun is first starting to come up
3. At the eleventh hour – at the last minute
4. Burn the midnight oil – working late into the night

How they might be used in a sentence:

Sentence 1: I'll be done with this assignment in no time.

Sentence 2: He wakes up at the crack of dawn every morning.

Sentence 3: Trying to get work done at the eleventh hour can be stressful.

Sentence 4: He often burned the midnight oil just to get his projects done in time.
